VERAMONTE CABERNET SAUVIGNON RESERVA, MAIPO VALLEY, CHILE

A big bold and rambunctious red that is just so flavoursome - blackcurrant flavours leap out immediately and start to wrestle with your tastebuds, then when you think you have had enough the mint starts to weigh in and you are completely bowled over - say hello to our little friend.

MONTEMARINO BARBERA DEL PIEMONTE, SANT'ORSOLA, ITALY

What a lovely, zingy, fruity chap we've found here. One glass and you'll want the bottle. A fine Barbera at a slinky price.

CHALONE VINEYARDS PINOT NOIR, MONTEREY COUNTY, USA

Soft and seductive with fragrant roses and ripe black cherries which invite the sense into this alluring Pinot Noir. Silky through the middle the wine crescendos on the finish, leaving a vibrant juicy memory in the mouth. Delicious

MERLOT DEL LAZIO TOGALE, FONTANA CANDIDA, ITALY

A velvety, plummy Merlot. A good all rounder that's very easy drinking...be careful!

ERRÁZURIZ 1870 TENO BLOCK MERLOT, CURICÓ VALLEY, CHILE

Velvet clad black cherries boogie on down your palate bringing sunshine and smooth action. We're having a sordid affair with this lovely gear, we might let you join in.

BLACKSTONE MERLOT, CALIFORNIA, USA

This wine is what we would describe as a bargain. A multi award winner with so much bright, vibrant plum fruit that you may need to wear a pair of shades when drinking it.

ROBERT SKALLI RESERVE PINOT NOIR, L'ÎLE DE BEAUTÉ, FRANCE

A drier style of Pinot from the unfortunately monikered Mr. Skalli. Plenty of fruit and good acidity, this cheeky fella wants to cut through our Goosenargh duck and he wants to do it now.

BERONIA, RIOJA, CRIANZA, SPAIN

You know, we like this. It's comfortable, familiar, well made, fruity Rioja. 100% Tempranillo, well balanced oak, smooth on the way out. Sometimes a little of what you know is good for you.

MORGON, BEAUJOLIAS, CUVÉE LUQUET, HENRY FESSY, FRANCE

This is what proper Beaujolais is all about. Well handled Gamay grapes, delicately fermented to produce, silky, fruity, soul-warming wine. Such a good natured wine will happily share a table with a great number of dishes but will be at its best with roast duck....

ROBERT SKALLI 'F' MERLOT, PAYS D'OC, FRANCE

Eighteen months in barrel, bottled unfiltered, this is how we want to be drinking southern French Merlot. Lovely, black cherry finish.

LUIS FELIPE EDWARDS RESERVA PINOT NOIR, CURICÓ VALLEY, CHILE

One of our favourites. Plenty of ripe berry fruits and delightfully slick tannins. A pleasant Pinot experience that will leave you wanting more.

ETCHART ARNALDO B, VALLE DE CAFAYATE, ARGENTINA

Concentrated dark fruit bombs it down your tongue as if on the run from Mexican bandidos, leaving a lush, smooth finish in its wake.

VERAMONTE PRIMUS, CASABLANCA VALLEY, CHILE

An explosion of blackberry and cherries! This mucky blighter adds Cabernet Sauvignon and Merlot to a healthy whack of Carmenere to send us into a dream like state of uber-relaxation. Get the buckles loosened, sit back and chillax-ercise

OVER THE SHOULDER CABERNET-MERLOT, YARRA VALLEY, AUSTRALIA

One seriously talented, multi award winning winemaker has created a wine which has an abundance of fruit but is perfectly balanced which is no mean feat in sunny Australia. The wine is seamless from the beginning to the last sip. A wine you'll come back to time and time again.

NOBILO ICON PINOT NOIR, MARLBOROUGH, NEW ZEALAND

This New World Pinot is assuredly proud of its French heritage. Initially loaded with plummy, cherry fruit these give way to a more savoury, herby character. Proper juice deserves a medium to rare piece of fillet, hold the sauce.

ST SUPÉRY ELU, NAPA VALLEY, USA

Oof. This is powerhouse of a wine. Bordeaux grape varieties give flavours of plum and black cherry which are perfectly balanced with smooth vanilla and hints of tobacco. This intense wine stays with you long after you have taken your final sip.

CHATEAU MUSAR RED GASTON HOCHAR, BEKAA VALLEY, LEBANON

Lebanon. Hochar. Mayhem. These crackers pioneers have been making wine in this war torn region for the best part of fifty or so years. The stunning blends of Cabernet Sauvignon, Cinsault and Carignan have given this winery critical success and an almost cult status amongst the wine boffins. The 2001 is ready and willing to deliver a whacking great mouthful of cherries and blackcurrants with a hint of ripe figs.Genius.

DUCK POND PINOT NOIR, OREGON, USA

Tough to describe this wine without getting all soppy and romantic. This beautifully subtle and elegant wine comes packed with blackcurrant and delivers it with a very refined and delicate finish. Superbly well made plonk that deserves your love and respect.

BERONIA, GRAN RESERVA, RIOJA, SPAIN

The big brother of the Crianza, and this big brother has got his shouting head on. Really well developed fruit, giving out to chocolate and really smooth tannins. There's no mucking about here, this is quality stuff.

BAROLO CRU RAVERA LO ZOCCOLAIO, DOMINI VILLA LANATA, ITALY

Made from one of Italy's big grapes, the dark and mysterious Nebbiolo, this Barolo delivers plums, prunes and a hint of white pepper. Will combine beautifully with the caramelisation on our perfectly cooked steaks and will also handle a creamy, peppercorn sauce.

AMARONE DELLA VALPOLICELLA CLASSICO, BOLLA, ITALY

Bolla was the first winery in the Veronese region to bottle and market Amarone back in 1953, although the tradition of using semidried grapes to increase the concentration of the wine goes back 1500 years. The grapes are dried on racks to concentrate the flavours before being pressed and fermented resulting in an incredibly rich and smooth taste sensation. Without doubt one of the greatest wines of our time.

ST SUPERY CABERNET SAUVIGNON, NAPA VALLEY, USA

We've put this bottle in our magic machine, we insist that you try it. Grand old black fruits with that unmistakable, welcome hint of eucalyptus. You can feel every drop of this gorgeous beast trickle right down. Genius. It'll shake your hand if you pair it with a good fillet steak but it'll marry you if you hide in a corner and enjoy, alone, singing Barry White songs to each other. True romance.

POMMARD, LOUIS JADOT, FRANCE

Almost tailor made for some of the meatier dishes on our menu, this is Pinot Noir in a fuller bodied, earthy, rustic style. Top vino from a top producer, one to brag about.

CHÂTEAU TEYSSIER, SAINT-ÉMILION GRAND CRU, FRANCE

We took a long time hunting down a top St.Emilion for our list. We believe this grand old fella delivers, bigtime. A Merlot dominated blend that wants savouring. Take your time....

FAUSTINO I RIOJA GRAN RESERVA, SPAIN

It's decanting time. We recommend our meat skewers or a medium rare fillet of beef to enjoy with this, rather insane wine. There's so much going on here it almost deserves its own book. Around forty years ago, one of Dionysus' finest disciples coaxed some humble berries into slowly creating a masterpiece. The resulting wine is now at its magnificent, complex, rustic, herbal, powerful, sublime best.

SPICY, PEPPERY, WARMING REDS

THE GOURMET SHIRAZ, SOUTH AUSTRALIA

Well made wine. A good dollop of jammy fruit without any cloying aftertaste. One to enjoy on its own, forget your troubles... let's do Shiraz

WRITER'S BLOCK PINOTAGE, WESTERN CAPE, SOUTH AFRICA

Wow. This is big Pinotage. Plenty of smokiness on the nose and huge dabs of fruit on the palate. There's a hell of a lot going on with this wine, it'll kick the backside out of any delicate food. Lamb skewers, definitely; try it, it might just rock your world.

ALIDIS TINTO 6 MESES BARRICA, VIÑA MAMBRILLA, RIBERA DEL DUERO, SPAIN

A great example of the earthy Tempranillo we can expect from the region. This wine has a real rustic yet comforting feel. Loads of fruit, good tannins. Get the lamb out!

CÔTES DU RHÔNE, LES RABASSIÈRES, FRANCE
